Course Description

6th Grade General Music is an Allied Arts course at Marie Murphy School that meets daily during either 2nd or 3rd period. In this course, students will focus on learning about music from countries around the world. Students will also learn music notation, composition, world drumming, and guitar.

Class Expectations

- Students are expected to be respectful—to each other, to the teacher, and to the materials and technology that we use in the music classroom. The music classroom will be a safe space for everyone to learn.
- Students are expected to be responsible. Students should arrive in class on time with all of the required materials. Repeated tardiness may result in disciplinary action. Students who are late for legitimate reasons should come to class with a pass signed by the office or another teacher.
- No food or drink other than bottled water (with a lid) are permitted in the music room. All bottled water should be kept on the floor and away from iPads, iMacs, and instruments.

Grading

1.) **Participation (20%):** Students will earn a weekly participation grade based on the rubric below.
